



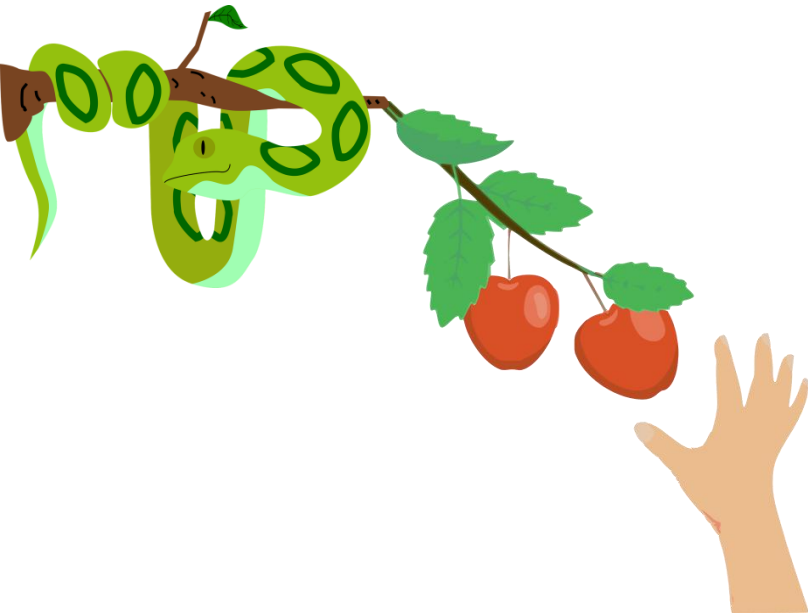

You can make them all fall.

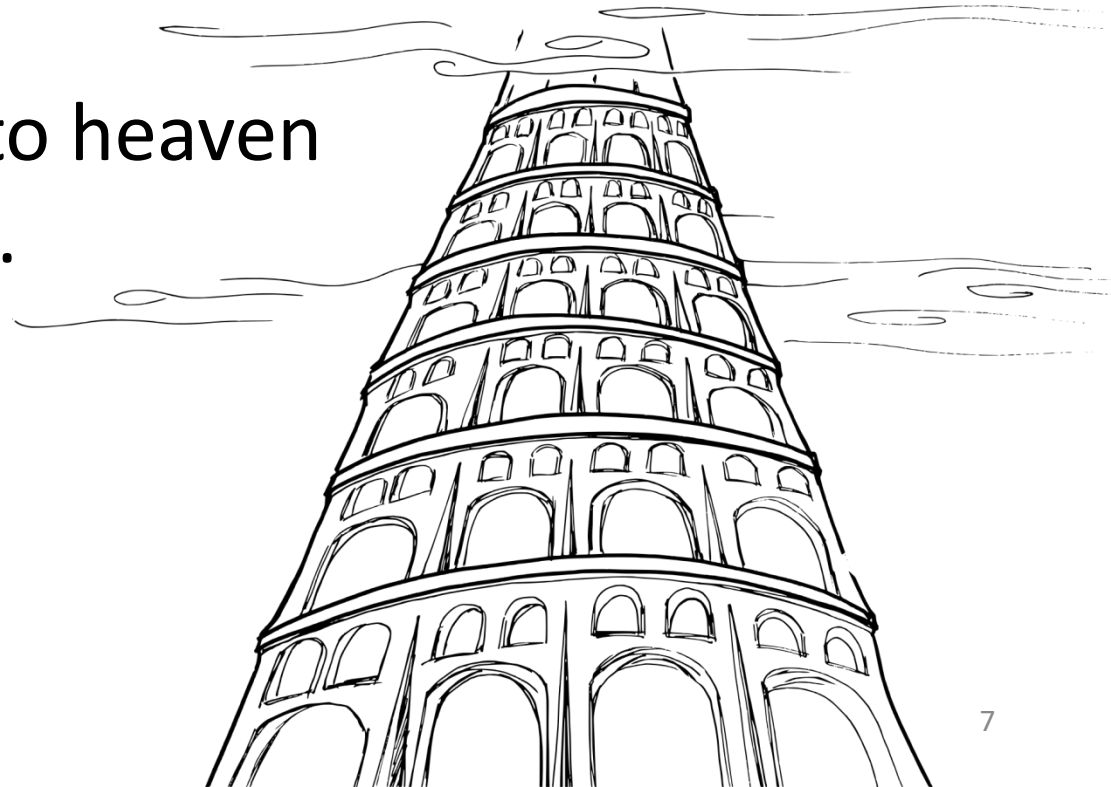


The Foolish King

Based on Moses in Exodus 17

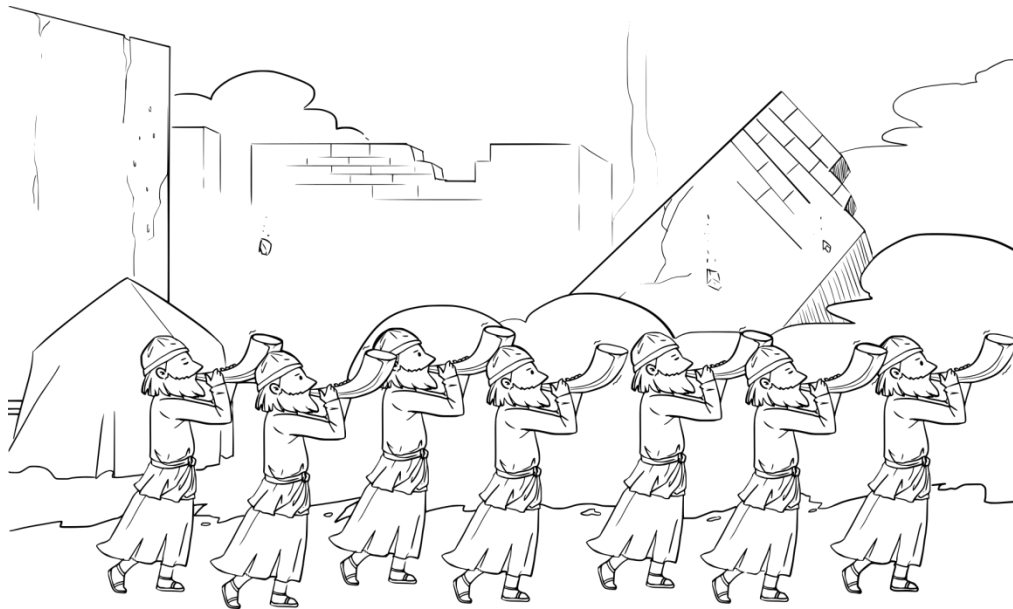
Some people were thirsty

Based on Jericho

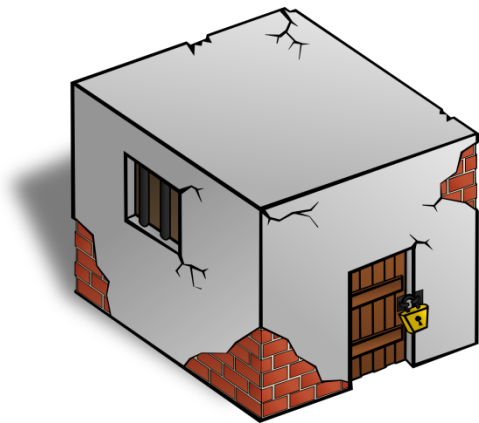
There once were tall walls surrounding a town.

Based on Joseph

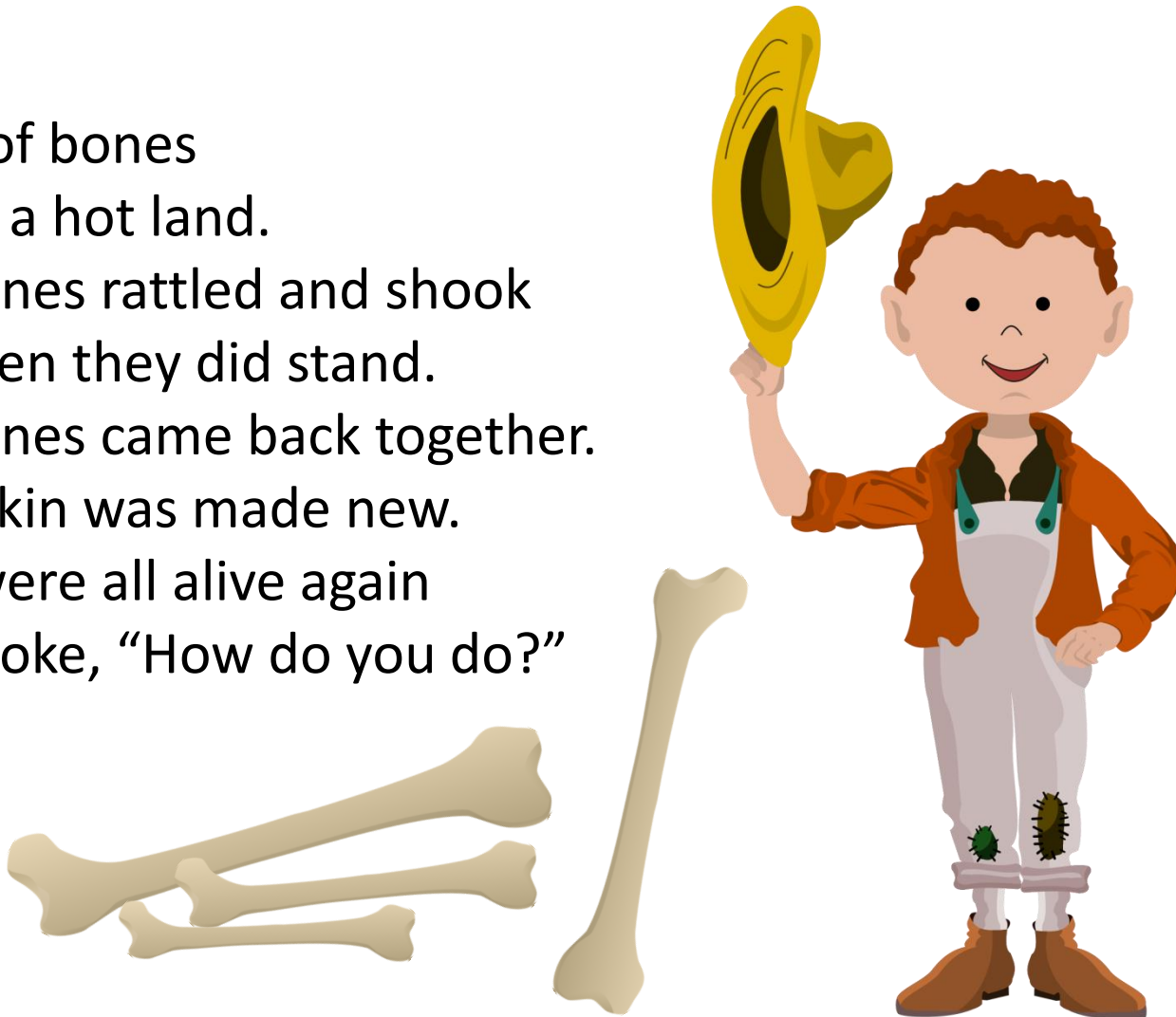
Some boys sold their brother

Based on The Ten Commandments

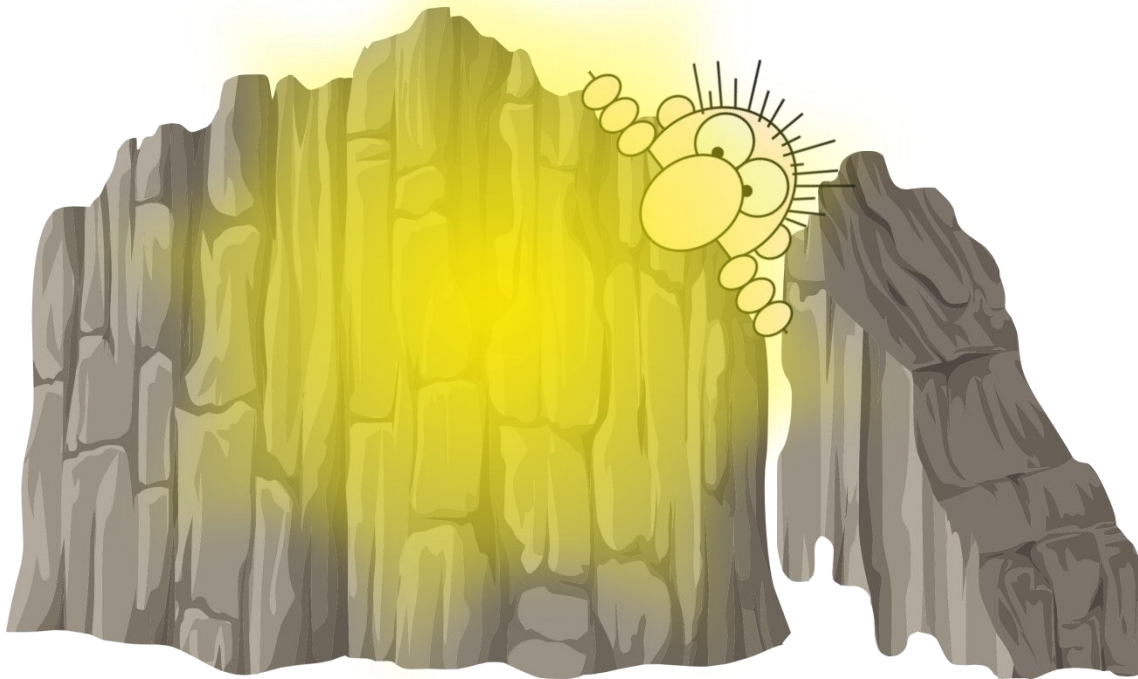
If you write rules on paper,

The Sun Is Bright

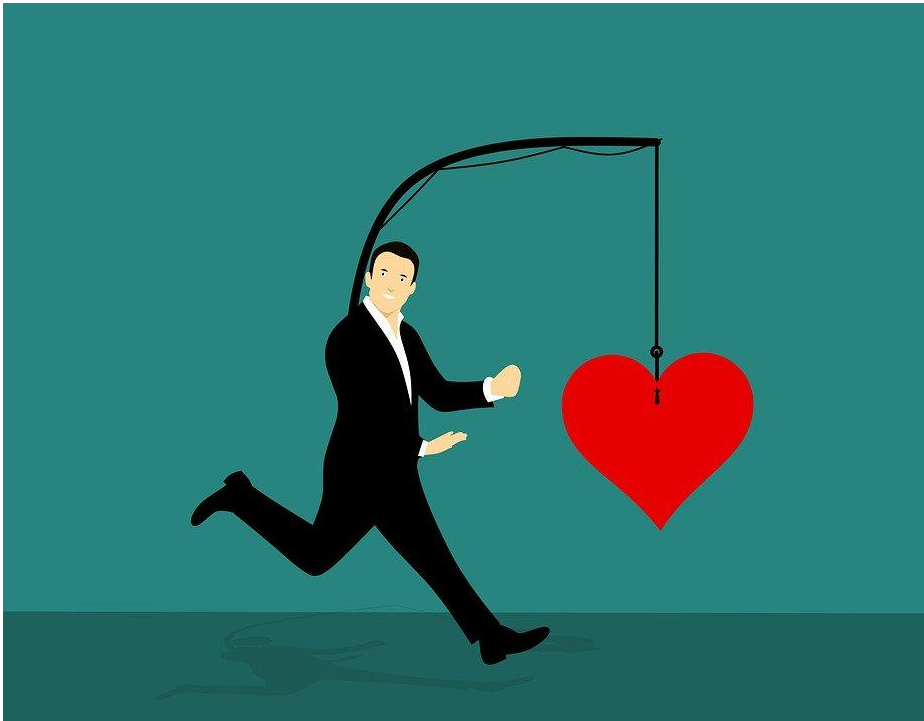
Based on Moses

Based on Proverbs 3:1-2

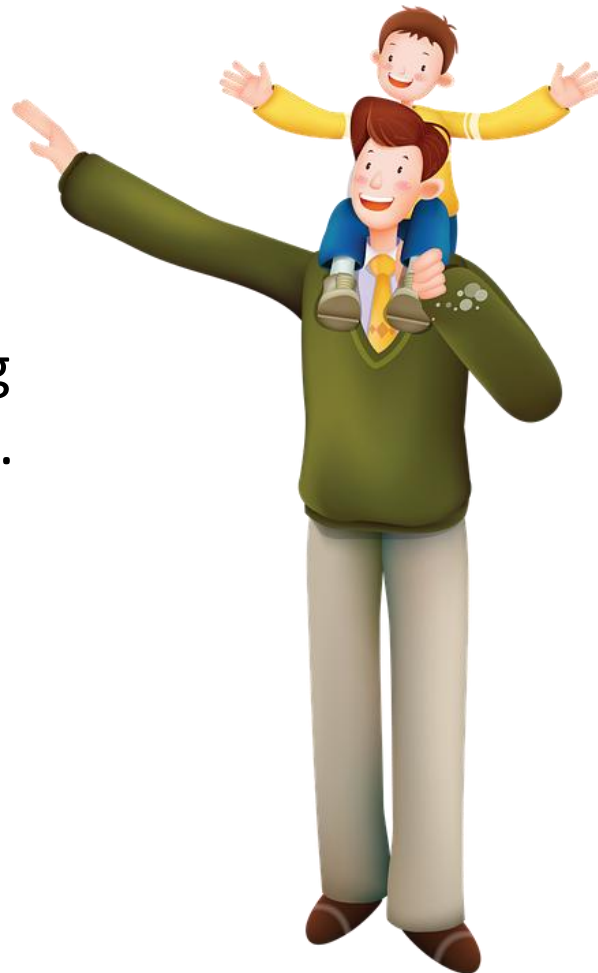


Your heart tells the truth.

Father Knows Best

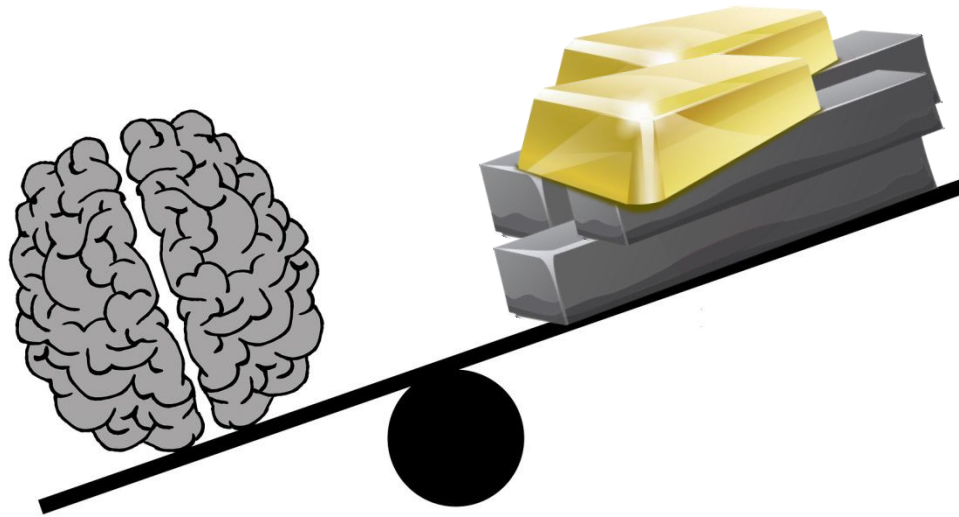
Based on Proverbs 3:7-8

Based on Proverbs 1:15

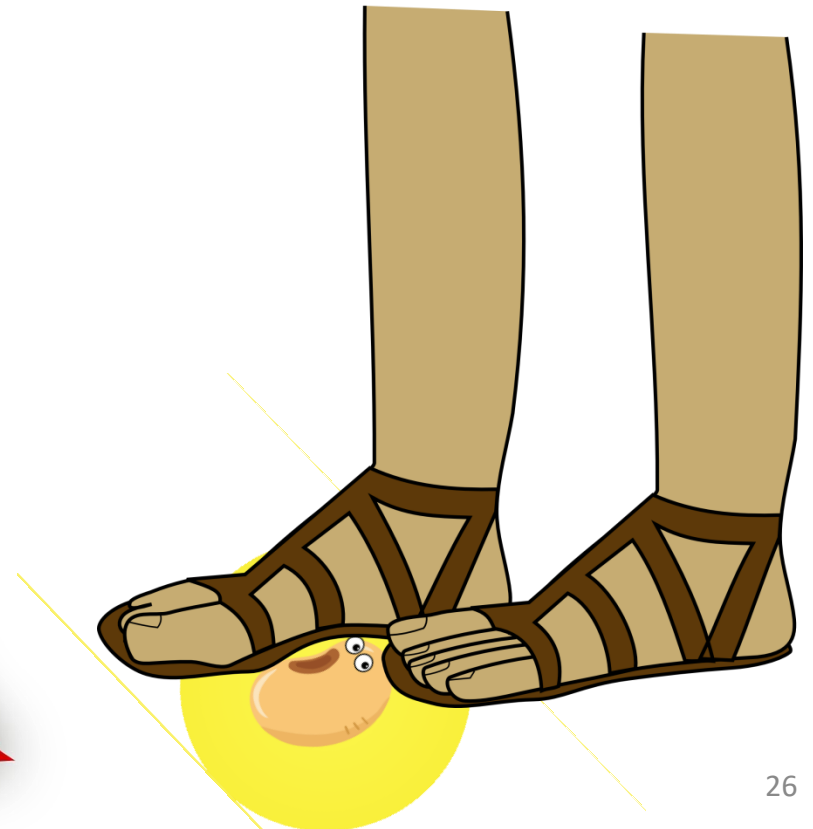
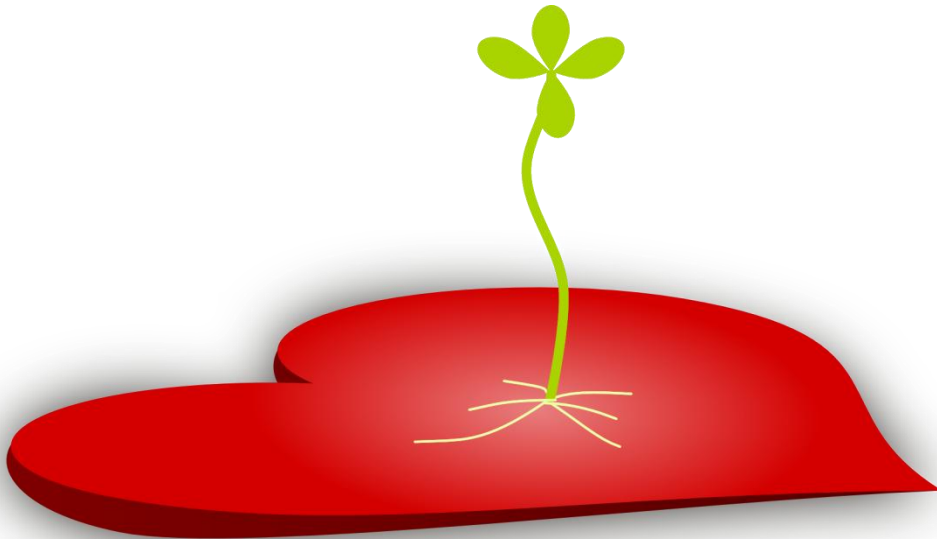
When you don't want to trip

Based on Matthew 13:30

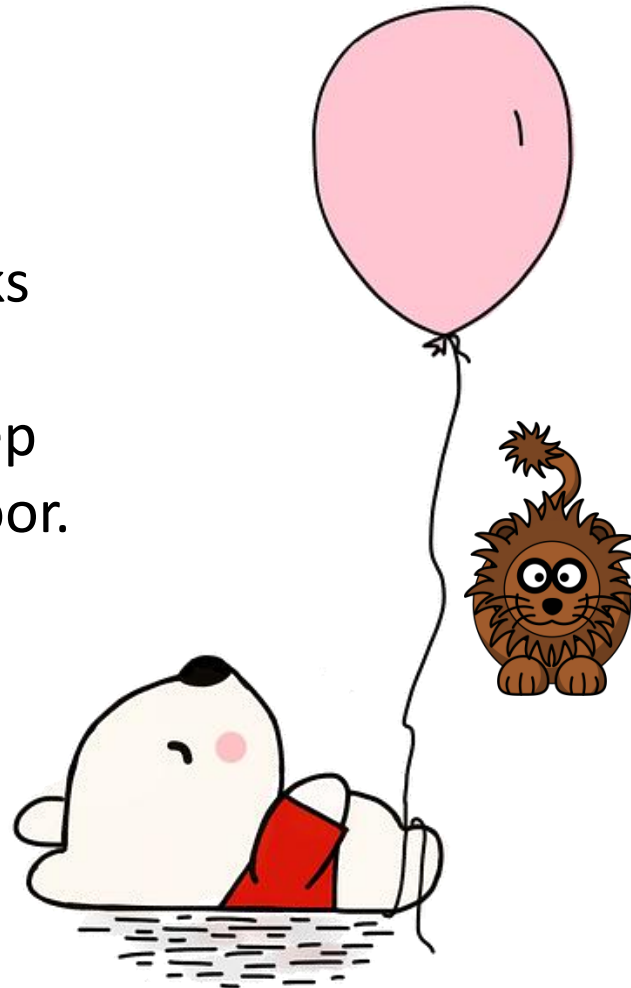
The crops are ready.

Teasing Attracts Bears

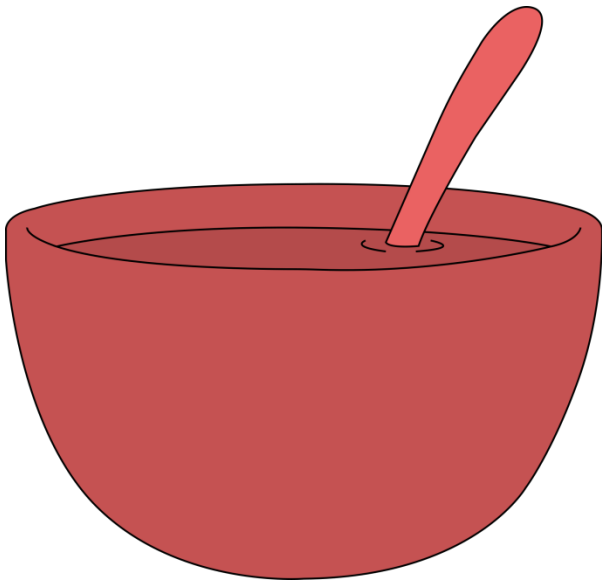
Based on 2 Kings 2:23-24

Based on Proverbs 3:6

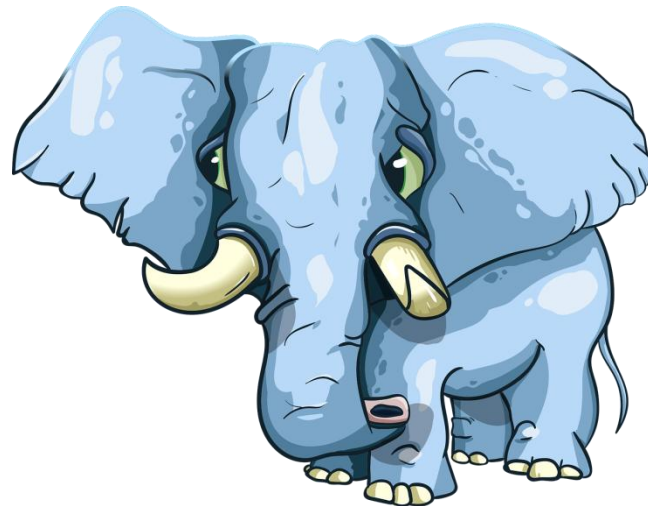
Do you see that rocky road ahead?

Based on Psalm 14:1 & Big Bang Gas Theory

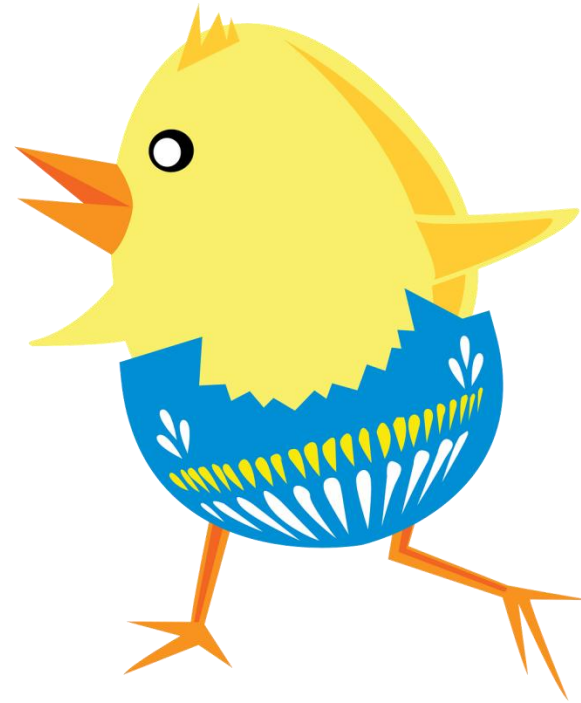
There was a fool whose name was Fred.

Based on Proverbs 1:30-31

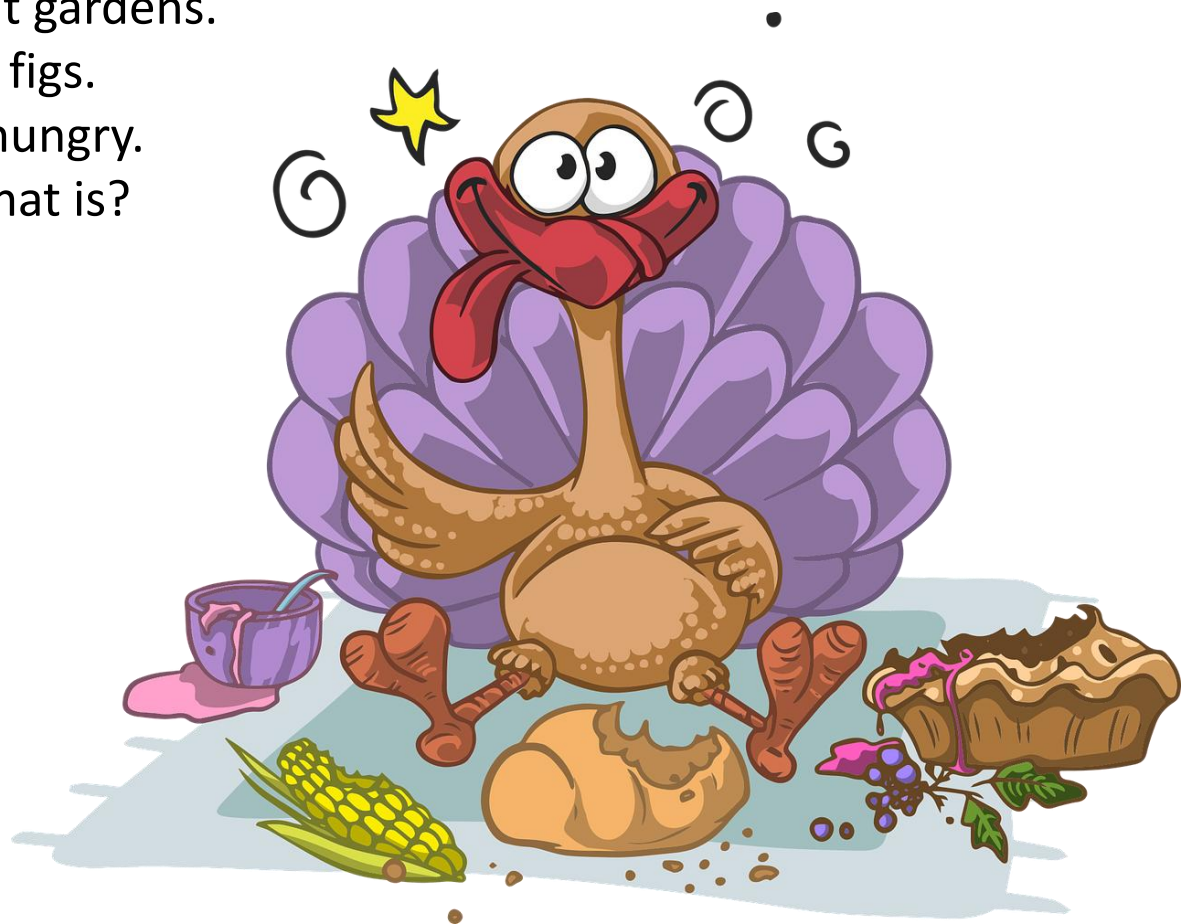
The little bird chirped in the night,

Based on Matthew 28-30

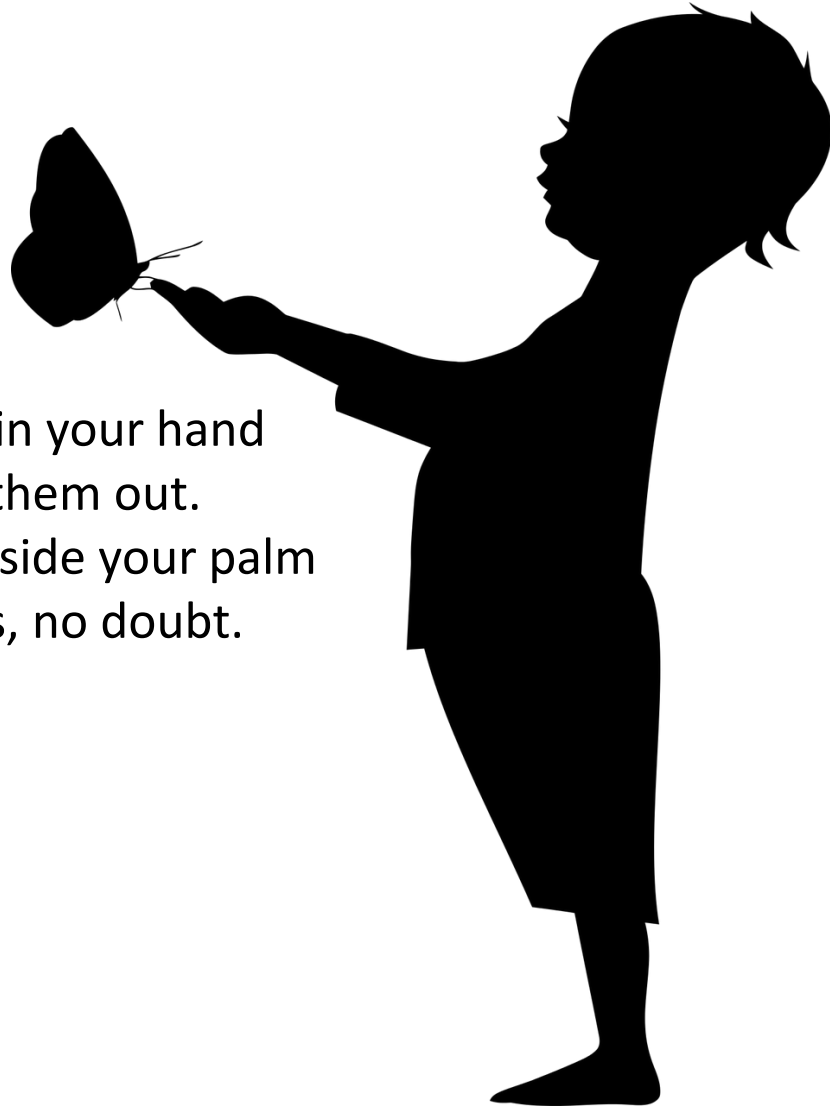


Do you often wonder

Based on John 10:28

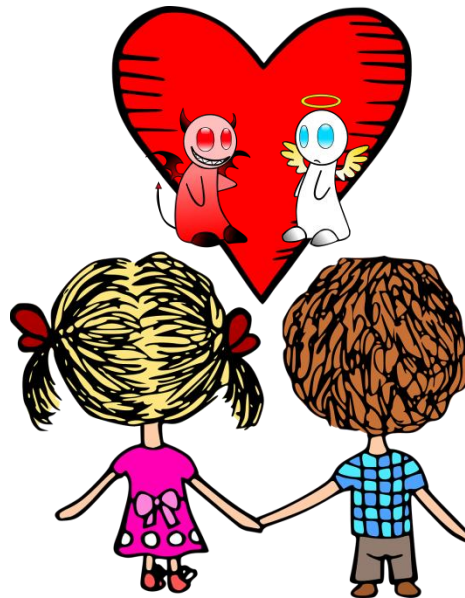
When you hold bugs in your hand
